



Thank you for your interest in the fundraiser gallery show Art for Animals!

This gallery art show will be held at Pope Mountain Arts (PMA) in Fort St. James, and will benefit the local not-for-profit animal rescue Fort St. James Animal Care Team Society (FSJ ACTS). The Animal Care Team has been working hard since its fruition in early 2024, and has connected Fort St. James and surrounding areas with valuable and vital services for animal welfare. This includes spay and neuter trips, vaccine clinics, fundraising efforts, education, animal food drives, animal rescue, transportation and rehoming.

As per the agreement with Pope Mountain Arts, 10% of your gallery art show sales will be paid to PMA for hosting. PMA is part of the Community Arts Council of Fort St. James, and is a non-profit society that supports the arts in Fort St. James.

Artists may choose whether they wish to donate all of their sales or keep up to 20%.

The remainder of sales will be donated to FSJ ACTS.

Submission Guidelines:

Theme: There is no theme for Art for Animals, however any animal theme or inspiration is highly encouraged. This is **not** a curated gallery.

Size & Number of Pieces: There are no limitations on size and number of submissions. However, we do ask that you take into consideration that there is limited spacing and this is a group event.

Medium: There are no limitations on medium types.

Deadline: Inventory submissions deadline is October 19th. This is when inventory lists as well as agreements should be completed and submitted to Pope Mountain Arts by October 19th and no later.

Opening Night: Friday, November 1st 6:30-8:30PM

Pick Up Day: Artwork may be picked up by the artists and buyers November 29th and 30th.



Artists may choose to remain anonymous. Your information is still required to keep track of your inventory and for payments.

EXHIBIT AGREEMENT

This agreement is between

Community Arts Council of Fort St. James, doing business as Pope Mountain Arts Centre
PO Box 846,
Fort St James, BC V0J1P0 (“PMA”)

and

Concerning the exhibit to be titled Art for Animals Fundraiser for the Animal Care Team (ACT) of Fort St. James

and to be held at the Pope Mountain Arts Centre’s premises located at 675 Birch Street, Fort St. James, BC V0J 1P0 (the “Centre”) between November 1st through November 28th, 2024.

The Artist will complete and submit to PMA before the opening of the exhibit an inventory list of the works to be exhibited. If it is a group exhibit, each Artist must complete their own inventory list.

The Artist is responsible for delivering the works to the Centre in “ready to hang” condition; this means the works are appropriately framed with hanging wire installed. If the Artist cannot be present to hang their works, PMA will display and hang the works at the Centre’s discretion.

The Artist will not sell or make any agreements to sell any exhibited work while it is exhibited at Pope Mountain Arts Centre.

PMA will keep a commission of 10% from each work that is sold at the Centre in order to cover costs of hosting the event. Payment in full for works sold must be made directly to the Community Arts Council of Fort St. James.

Works displayed in the exhibition must not be removed until after the exhibit comes down, unless sold by the artist to an out-of-town buyer. Exceptions may be made at the discretion of PMA if a suitable substitute work by the Artist can be hung in its place.

PMA may host other public events in the Centre while the exhibit is ongoing.

PMA does not have insurance coverage for works exhibited at the Centre. PMA will not be held responsible for damage, theft, or other mishandlings that may occur during the show.
